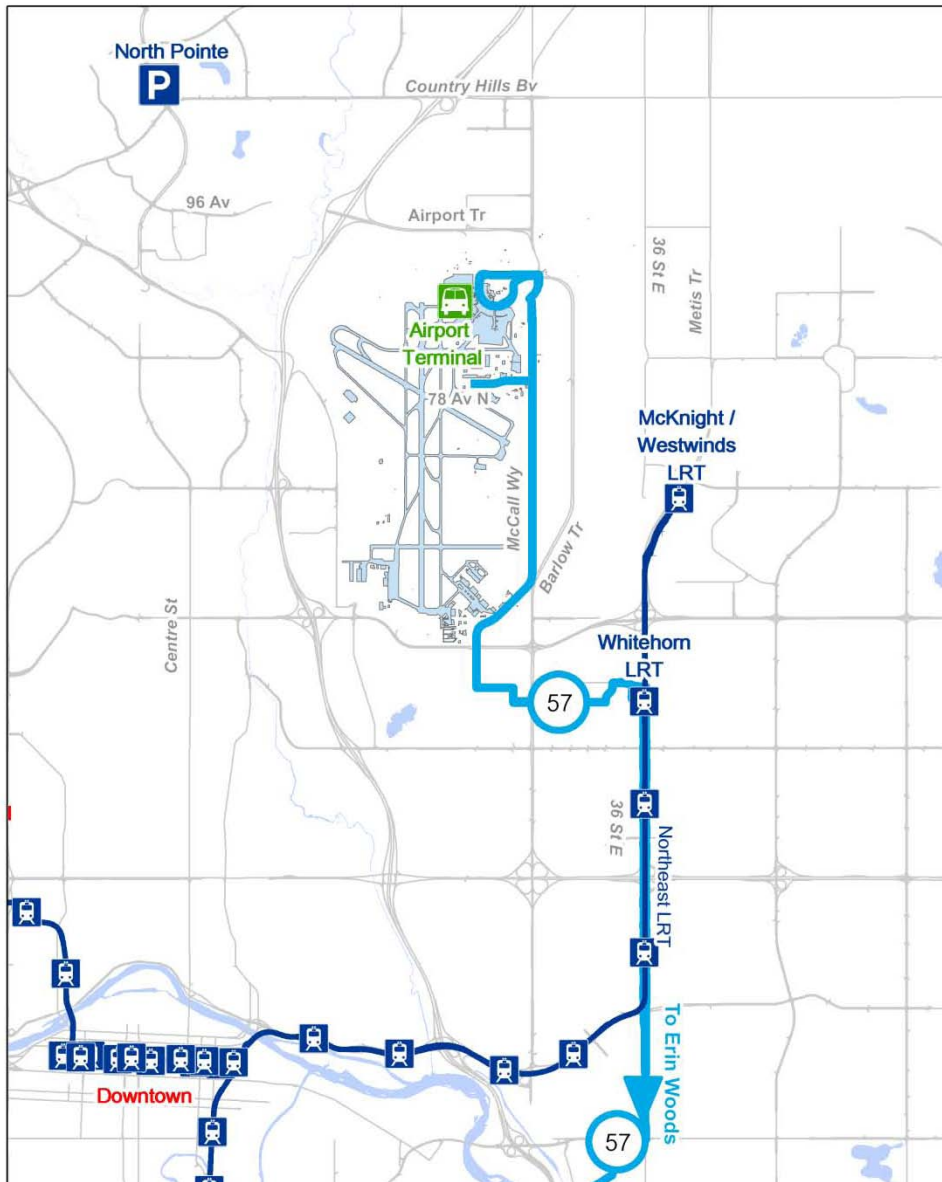
Calgary Transit is committed to providing high quality transit service to the Calgary International Airport to serve airport staff, air travelers and those visiting Calgary.

- Canada's Fourth Busiest Airport
12,180,000 passengers per year (2009)
- Estimated growth to 21.9M passengers
per year by 2028
- 15,000 Airport Employees (2010)

- Serves the Airport Terminal, McCall North / South and Pegasus Industrial Areas. Connection to NE LRT at Whitehorn Station
- 20 Minute Weekday AM/PM Peak Period Service
- 30 Minute Midday and Evening Service
- 30 Minute Saturday and Sunday Service

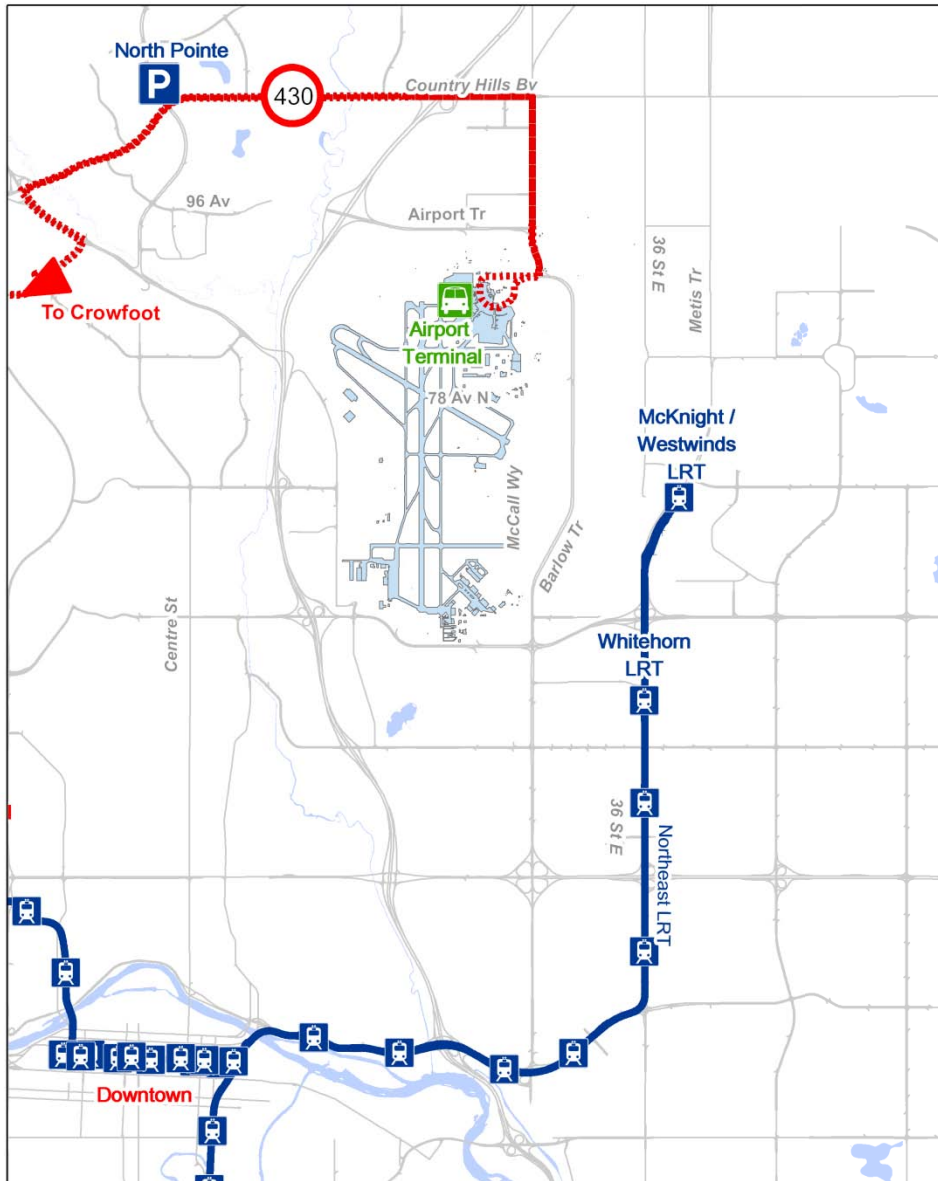


Route 57

- Connection to Northpointe Terminal (301 BRT) and NW LRT at Crowfoot Station via Country Hills BV

- 3 late evening trips (leaving the airport at 10:23pm, 11:23pm, 12:23am)
- No Saturday, Sunday or Holiday Service

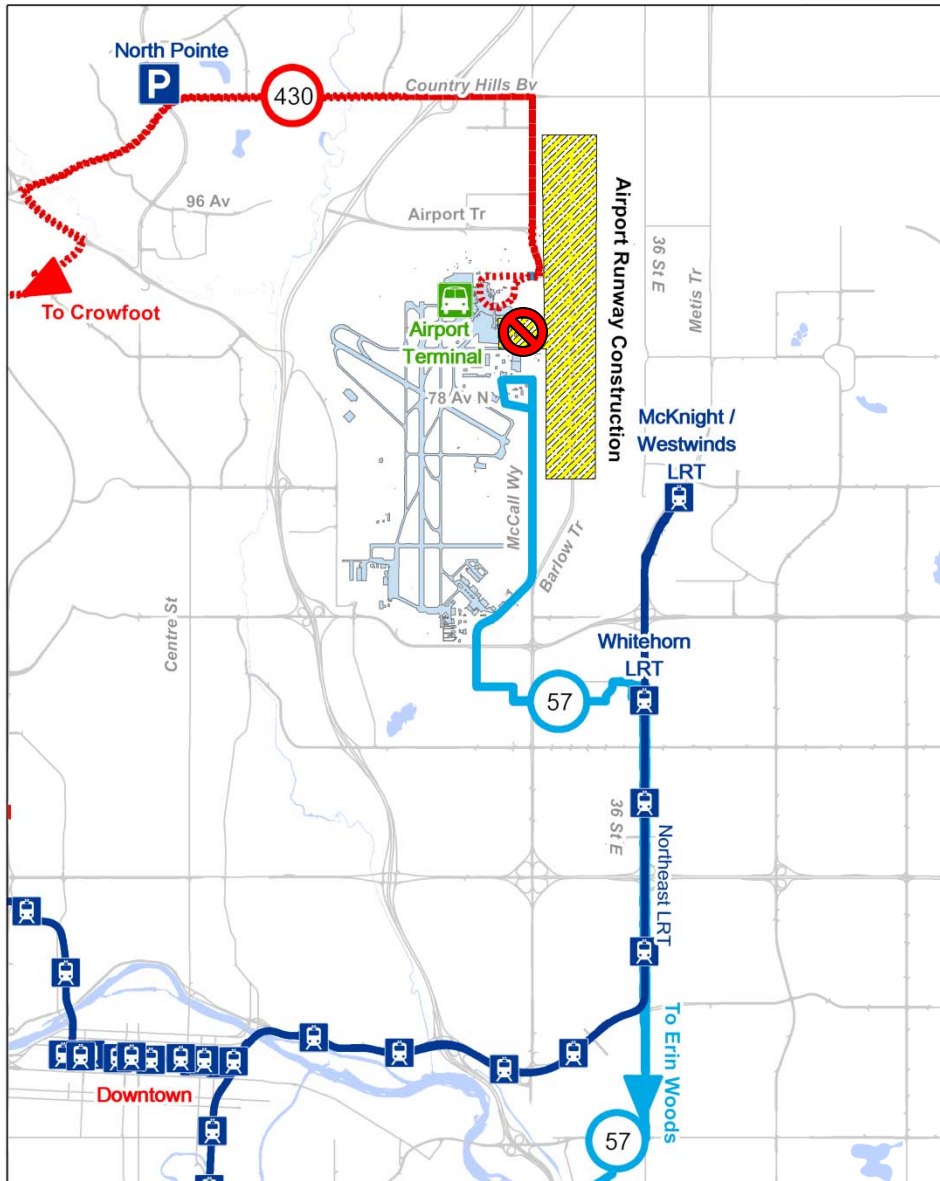

2011 Changes

- Calgary International Airport runway construction begins in April 3, 2011
- Due to construction the new Airport runway cuts Route 57 off from the Airport terminal
- A new bus route to the Airport is needed to continue providing a transit connection to/from Northeast Calgary

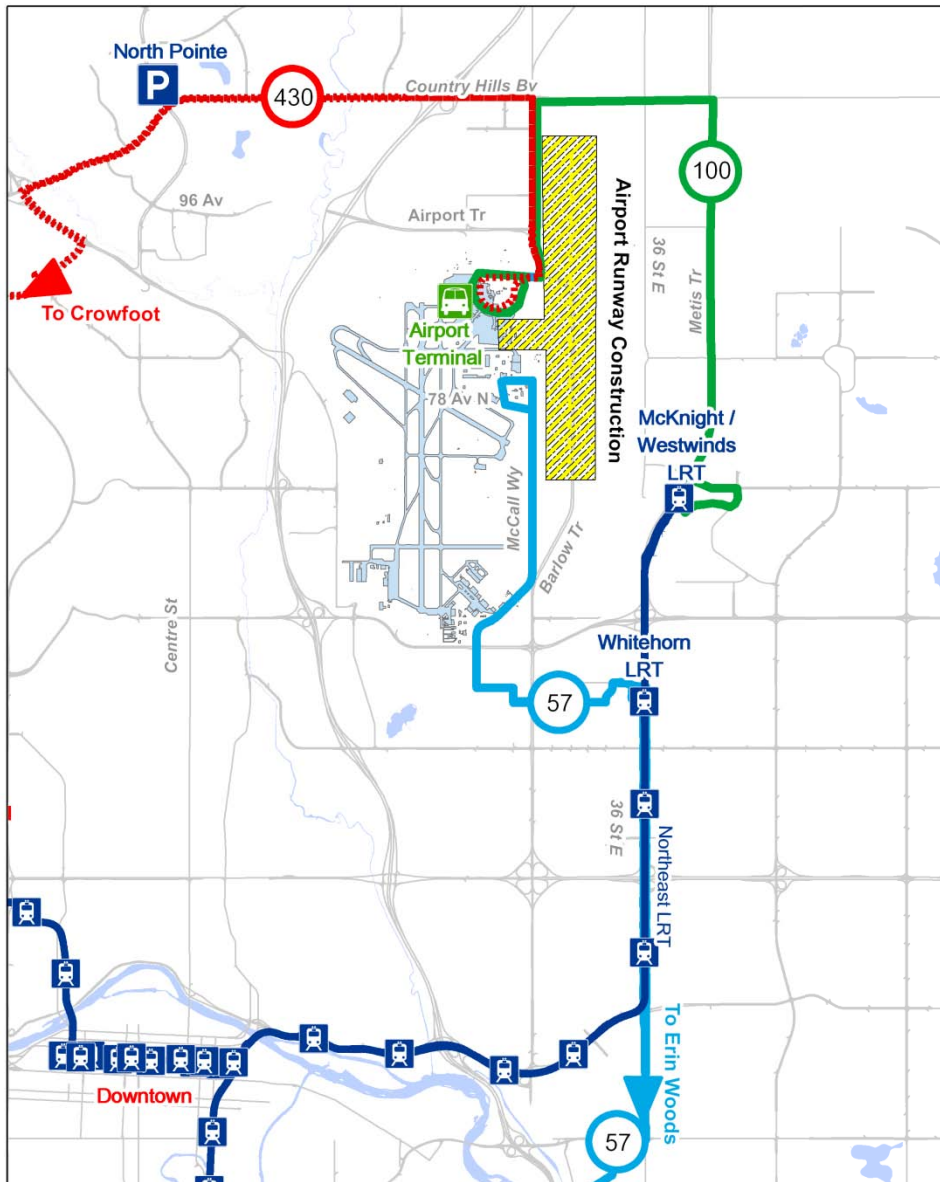


2011 Proposed Airport Service Route 100

New Route 100: to serve Airport Terminal via Metis Trail and Country Hills Blvd.

Direct express service to/from McKnight-Westwinds LRT Station

- Route 57: Terminating at 78 Avenue
- Route 430: No Change

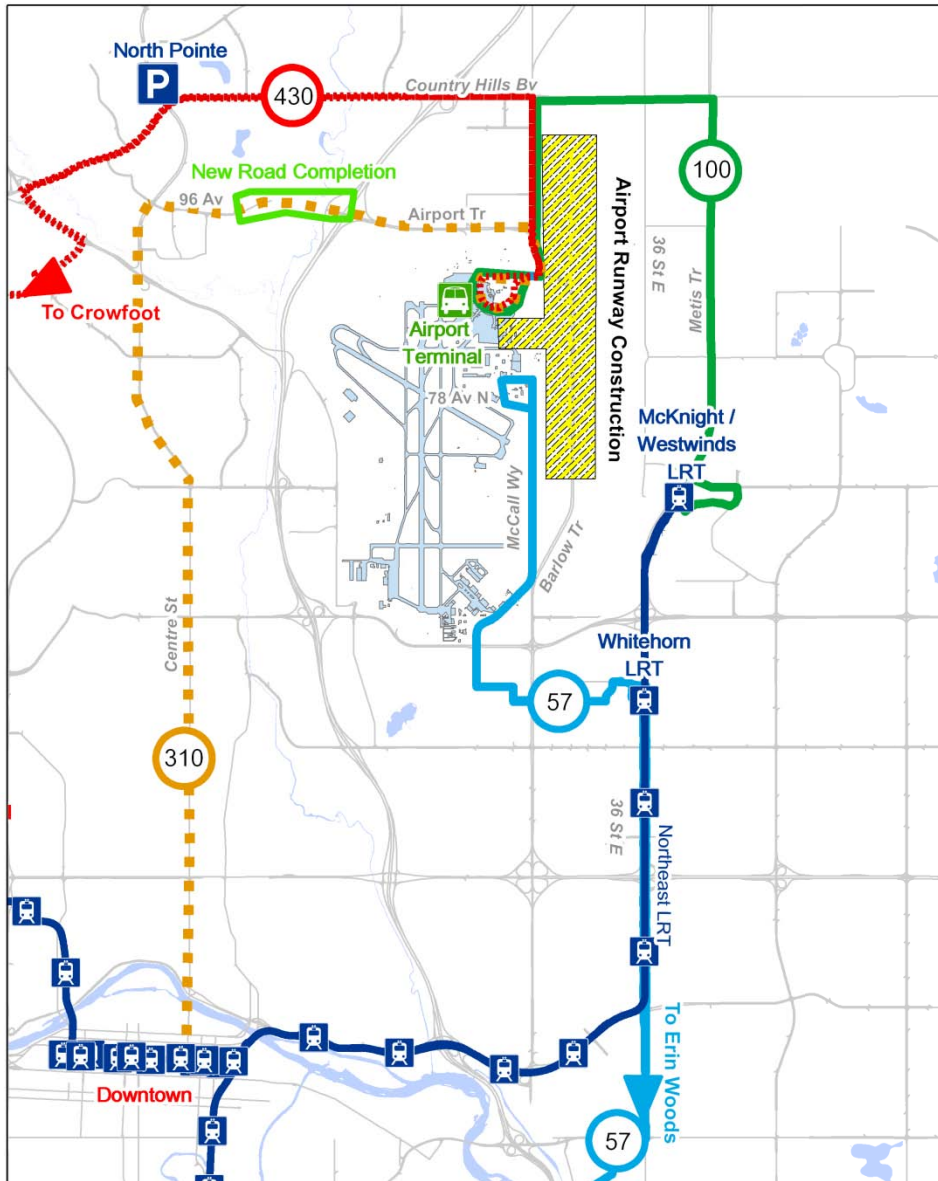

Proposed Airport Express

Route 310

- Downtown Airport Express (Route 310): limited stop BRT between the Airport Terminal & Downtown along Centre Street and Airport Trail.
- Route 430: Serves NW Calgary
- Route 57 & 100: Serves NE Calgary



Proposed Long Range Plan Centre Street Airport Tram

A European style tram or streetcar, operating on Centre Street & 96 Avenue, could replace the Airport BRT to provide higher capacity and more frequent service to/from Downtown, the Calgary International Airport and the future proposed high speed rail station.
